2nd Edition NSQHS Standards

From the 1st January 2019, Australian health-service organisations must comply with the revised 2nd edition of the National Safety and Quality Health Services (NSQHS) standards to achieve and maintain their government accreditation.

Health service organisations will be assessed once every three years, unless they are found to have exceeded the Commission's maximum number of "not met" actions, at which point they will be required to be reassessed within six months.

If an organisation has actions which are not met at their initial assessment, there is a remediation period in which they must demonstrate sufficient change has been implemented to be awarded accreditation.

Eligible organisations can elect to move to a short-notice assessment pathway where they will have to demonstrate their compliance assessors to specific Standards at short notice.

Compliance Self-Assessment

The Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Health Care (the Commission) recommends health-service organisations undertake regular self-assessments against the NSQHS Standard's to optimise their chances of achieving and maintaining their accreditation.

Self-assessments should identify those quality and safety actions where compliance is being achieved, including supporting evidence, and those actions where compliance is not being achieved.

Continuous Improvement

The self-assessment process should also include the development and monitoring of action plans to cover any identified actions where compliance is not being achieved, allocated responsibilities, and set time-frames for improvement.

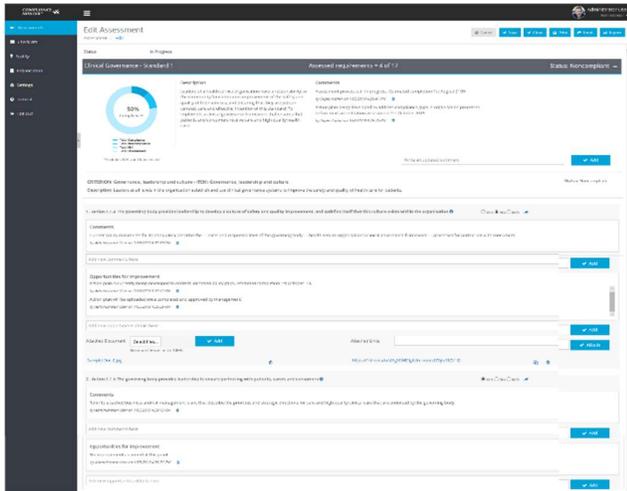

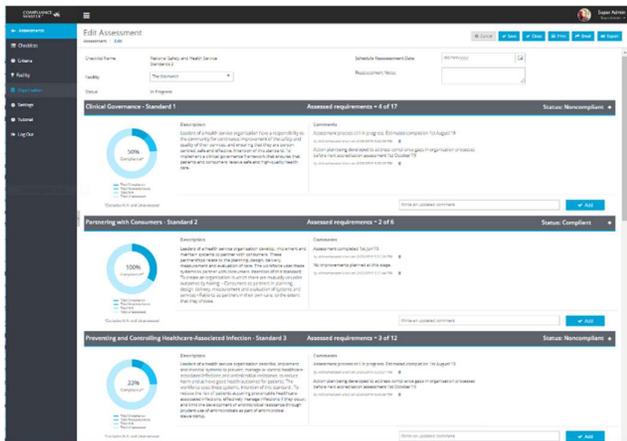
